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Energy & Environmental Policy Statement

Kirklees Active Leisure operations have a significantly impact on the environment and seeks to minimise this impact in the interest of its trustees, customers, employees, partners and the general public. The Chief Executive and Chair of the Trustees, recognise that sound environmental management is vital to our business and as such will be integrated into our management and business procedures.

The aims of the policy are to:

- **Meet** all applicable government guidelines, regulations and codes of practice. As an absolute minimum achieve Kirklees Councils carbon reduction budget of 3% per annum.
- **Make** efficient use of natural resources, minimising waste and conserving energy and water, to which end an action plan has been drawn up. This plan will be updated each year.
- **Review** of the action plan and will be reported to the Trustee's annually
- **Promote** environmental awareness and understanding amongst all our staff and to seek their active participation in environmental activities
- **Prevent** pollution from our operations
- **Promote** exchange of information between relevant bodies in order to share best practice
- **Establish** preventative maintenance schemes to maintain the energy reduction
- **Endeavour** to ensure that all new projects and modifications to our facilities meet the highest standards of environmental conservation.
- **Accreditation** will be maintained with EMAS and KAL will also take part in Yorkshire and Humberside Business in the Community 'Environmental Index'. KAL will also participate in Kirklees Council's National indicator NI185 and NI186.

This policy will be regularly monitored to ensure that it remains relevant and that it is being effectively implemented. A full review of the policy will be undertaken on at least an annual basis or as required by changing legislation.
